**“EYE IN THE SKY” PROJECT MOVING FORWARD**

***NJ State Treasury Selects CIBER, Inc. To Perform All Necessary Work***

**CAMDEN** – Mayor Dana L. Redd today announced that CIBER, Inc. has been awarded a contract from the State of New Jersey to design, engineer, and deploy a state-of-the-art surveillance system and communications network project for the City of Camden. The project, also known as the “Eye in the Sky” program, will enhance our law enforcement efforts and provide safe streets for residents, visitors, and businesses in the City.
