Discussion:

Purpose is to consider a change to ordinance regulating distance between properties with liquor licenses.

Legal requirements in establishing possible areas and appeal rights for those with property interests

What possible areas should be included

- Waterfront?
- Haddon Avenue?
- Federal Street?

What establishments should be included:

- Only restaurants with bars?
- Bars?

Concern raised whether additional bar and/or bar-restaurant in zones will cause an increase in crime.

-Proposed solution: pilot selections in 1-3 zones.

- -determine whether crime rates in area increase and type of crimes committed.
- -impact on quality of life

Goal is to increase business opportunities while decreasing crime rate

-Focus is on a shift of culture and improvement of quality of life
-Bar-restaurant appears to be best solution for pilot selection

Can an owner/operator transfer an ABC liquor license from a bar to a bar-restaurant?

- Research will be needed on this issue
 - Result: Transfer from bar to bar-restaurant is permissible because same plenary retail consumption license.
 - Change from liquor store (distribution license) to bar or barrestaurant (consumption license) is not permitted.
