CHAIRMAN DeJESUS: Planning Board Director's Report.

DR. WILLIAMS: Thank you, Mr. Chair and Members of the Board. I'll just report on one item on today, Angela and myself attended a meeting at Rutgers for training today regarding planning board and zoning boards planning and zoning issues as current issues.

A couple of issues came up during the meeting regarding Board review, site plan applications, understanding the difference between variances and waivers, as well as focusing on case law regarding split-zone zoning, height variances, as well as a major section regarding a commercial speech and noncommerical speech relative to signs. And the importance of making sure our sign ordinances are up-to-date according to case law to avoid any litigation that may affect the City or affect any

Board members.

The other thing that was mentioned during the meeting was, that there are cases involving members who have went beyond their reach in terms of opinions and discussion and they were found to not have immunity from the lawsuits, and that's a major issue. That's something for Board members to always remember. Opinions should be directly tied to the Site Plan Ordinance. It cannot be based on personal fill-ins or opinions about the applicant or the area or anything that's not related to the application.

I can go further, Mr. Chair, but it's just a reminder to all of us on the Board to make sure that we stay abreast of any points and comments that we make regarding an application; that we stick to the Site Plan Ordinance; stick to the Zoning Ordinance and defer any concerns to our Board Counsel who will help us to filter them out to make sure that our records is solid and that it's clean.

Again, I can go into more detail but tonight I'll just give you some snippets and may discuss some other issues during next month's meeting.
